- 4. NEW BUSINESS: Maria Siskind introduced our speaker Margaret Roach whose presentation entitled *Non-Stop Plants: The 365-Day Garden* was enjoyed by all the members. It was a very entertaining talk about finding ways to enjoy your garden all year long. Some of her suggestions:
 - Find areas in your yard to "unmow" to increase diversity
 - Encourage all the different types of beneficial creatures (including snakes and bugs)
 - Look at your garden from inside the house so you can better visualize the scale, look from places where you'd spend time during different seasons
 - Embrace shapes for visual appeal even when nothing is blooming; look at the shapes of the trunks, for example
 - Margaret thinks of it as a 6-season garden: January/February = conception, March/April = birth, May/June = youth, July/August = adulthood, September/October = senescence, November/December = death and afterlife
 - Notice and enjoy plants at all the different stages, not just peak bloom; enjoy buds though the passing leaves.
 - Try to leave your tree stumps; many animals and the soil will benefit; same thing with fall cleanup
 - Read the light at all seasons
 - Add water if you can; all species depend on it; consider temporary or seasonal water features
 - Consider finding a signature plant or color and repeating it throughout your garden
 - Margaret gave us a handout which includes a shopping list of 365 day plants
 - Check out Margaret's website: A Way to Garden.com and sign up for her newsletter and podcast.
