Matt has been the Grounds Manager at the Clark for 10 years and spoke about changes and plans at the 140-acre campus of the Clark. Some of the highlights:
 - a. Goal is to build the soil rather than the plants.
 - b. Grass looks very good due to constant overseeding rather than use of weed repellents.
 - c. In improved areas, choice has been to plant a greater variety with staggered plantings.
 - d. The meadow has been improved with twice annual mowings.
 - e. Water management has focus of review with several areas of improvement.
 - f. Education is a focus of activities; Matt's team uses all opportunities to educate groups visiting the campus.
 - g. Ozone bubbles were added to the water feature on the lower campus.
 - h. Beekeeping was introduced three years ago with six hives.
 - i. Outdoor exhibits have been added.
 - j. Matt views the full campus as gallery space; as the steward of the campus, his goal is to foster the landscape for the next generation.
- 6. COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS: Matt took questions throughout and at the end of his presentation. Thanks were given to Matt for this very interesting talk.
